

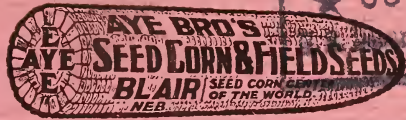

Should we be out of kind of seed ordered we reserve the right to cancel order or write you whether or not we shall substitute. We guarantee our seeds to please you. You can keep and test seeds bought from us 10 days and if not entirely satisfied return them and we will send back your money. That's fair. Don't you think so? But we do not and cannot guarantee a stand or a crop. The prices shown are for bushel or 100-lb quantities. If less is ordered of course we must have a little more money, but send in your order and we will fix it up so it's right.
